PROGRAM STRUCTURE

01

6-WEEK SUMMER TRAINING

Prior to the start of their teaching placement, a 6-week summer training is arranged for fellows. The training includes multi-dimensional workshops to prepare fellows for their teaching placement and further career and leadership development.

02

10-MONTH TEACHING PLACEMENT

After the training, fellows will start their teaching placement at our partner schools to serve underprivileged students for 10 months. The main duties of our Fellows are (1) In-class Teaching, (2) Extra-curricular Activities and (3) Life and Career Education.

03

POST-FELLOWSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Teach4HK encourages and supports fellows to explore careers beyond education. We have already established partnership with corporates such as KPMG, UOB, SFC, and EY to provide career opportunities for our graduated fellows.

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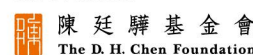

About Teach4HK

Teach4HK is an education non-profit organization that seeks to enlist passionate university graduates to serve in schools with underprivileged students through a one-year teaching fellowship. We partner with businesses and institutions to provide leadership and career opportunities to nurture the youngsters to become leaders with empathy, who will thrive in various fields and continue to advocate for education.

We are now recruiting university graduates who are passionate in education to be our teaching fellows 2018-2019.

Program Structure



Leadership, Social Entrepreneurship and Career development are key elements that you will experience as a Teach4HK Fellow. Fellows are not only teachers in classrooms, but also leaders and change makers in schools.

Successful applicants will join our Teach4HK 2018-2019 Fellowship. If selected, you will need to attend 2-month Summer Training in July 2018 by education professors before embarking teaching. After Summer Training, you will be placed in a Teach4HK partner school and teach in classes depending on your interests and academic focus for a full academic year. Your growth is a key part of the one-year experience, that is why we provide you with career guidance and arrangement for your various post fellowship opportunities.



Fellows Duties / Responsibilities

Teaching fellows are required to commit to 1-year Teaching Fellowship including 2-months summer training and 10-month teaching placement in our local partner schools with underprivileged students from July 2018 to June 2019.

To well prepare fellows for the challenges, fellows have to complete the 2-month summer training before you start the teaching placement. During your school placement, you have 3 main responsibilities:

- i. Conduct classroom teaching
- ii. Coach students for career & life planning with Teach4HK's business partners
- iii. Lead diversified learning projects

Minimum Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in any discipline
- Flexibility to work in any of our schools

Humility, Respect, and Empathy

As a Teach4HK fellow you will be working with a variety of stakeholders – from students to parents, teachers to peers. We look for those that can build relationships quickly, giving value and respect to others to get the best out of them.

Interaction

Communicating clearly whilst listening and responding appropriately is very important. As a fellow you will need to adapt your style in different situations and contribute as a great team player.

Knowledge

You will need to show passion for Teach4HK, our vision and mission, as well as understanding and enthusiasm for the Fellowship Program.

Leadership

You will need to be proactive and make decisions on a daily basis as you strive to achieve above and beyond expectations. Taking the lead will be crucial for success.

Planning and Organizing

As a Teach4HK fellow you will need to manage daily responsibilities and juggle your priorities. You will need to work efficiently and effectively to meet deadlines and deliver successfully.

Problem Solving

Every day you will face new challenges and will have to come up with considered, effective and appropriate solutions in response. Whilst drawing on resources and logic you will also need to use creativity and innovation to be successful.

Resilience

You will need to be hungry for a challenge, using patience and endless energy to persevere through the difficult times. When faced with obstacles you will need to be tenacious and versatile and maintain a positive mindset.

Self-Awareness

Personal development is vital for long term success. You will need to be aware of your performance, your strengths and your weaknesses and will need to be realistic in what and how you can do better.

Global Exposure

Underprivileged students lack exposures to outside world and through sharing of your international experiences, you can create a long lasting impact to students' learning.
