Introduction about Teach for China

Our vision: One day, all children in China will enjoy access to a quality education.

Teach for China (TFC) was launched to tackle the serious imbalance of educational resources between urban and rural areas. Launched in 2008 as a non-profit program managed by the Lead Foundation.

The Lead Foundation is a non-profit organization registered with the Beijing Civil Affairs Bureau, April 2014. The Lead Foundation is one of the first, in Beijing, to be officially recognized as a charitable organization. Since inception, China Foundation Center has consistently awarded The Lead Foundation an FTI*[note] score of 100 each year, making it one of the most transparent foundations nationwide.

Since 2008, Teach for China has recruited, trained and placed more than 1,900 teachers to work as full-time teachers in rural communities in China, lacking the sufficient educational resources. More than 1,534,000 classes have been taught in approximately 300 middle and elementary schools in Yunnan, Guangdong, Gansu, Guangxi and Fujian, reaching over 427,000 students.

Description of Teach For China Fellowship

TFC is a program of the non-profitable organization- The Lead Foundation.

We utilize a variety of channels to aggressively recruit Chinese candidates from top universities in China. Applicants undergo a rigorous selection process prioritizing core competencies. TFC's intensive Summer Institute prepares fellows to be effective teachers, strong cross-cultural communicators, and meaningful, long-term contributors to their placement communities. In cooperation with local educators, we place fellows in under-resourced schools selected for demonstrated student need. Fellows share their knowledge and brainstorm solutions to local challenges. Once they enter the classroom, fellows receive the support of full-time instructional coaches who engage in joint problem solving to boost student achievement. The two years that fellows serve in the classroom represent only the beginning of their potential to have a profound impact upon the students we serve.

In the long term, we will develop a network of leaders working across a variety of sectors to end educational inequality in China.
