## **China's Education Challenge**

In China today, where you are born determines your educational prospects and therefore life opportunities. Affluent urban centers spend up to five times as much educating students on a per capita basis compared to low-income communities while early education and foreign language resources are almost unheard of outside of major cities. The impact of this inequality is dramatic: nearly 80% of students from Tier 1 Chinese cities will have the chance to attend college, with only 5% of poor rural students receiving the same opportunity. In urban areas, the more than 20 million children who live in cities with their migrant worker parents also lack access to high-quality educational resources.

If education is the key to escaping poverty, then millions of children in China face daunting if not impossible odds.



The future of China's children—and of the country—rest on closing this gap. We need the best and brightest from China's next generation working to solve this problem.
